Cello Standards: Dynamics

ppp - pianississimo - very, very gentle, soft - less than a whisper
pp - pianissimo - very gentle, soft - at a whisper volume
p - piano - gentle, soft - almost at a whisper
mp - mezzo piano - (mezzo) half/middle/medium (piano) gentle/soft - softer than speaking voice
mf - mezzo forte - (mezzo) half/middle/medium (forte) strong/loud - speaking voice
f - forte - strong, loud - louder than speaking
ff - fortissimo - very strong/loud - shouting, yelling
fff - fortississimo - very, very strong/loud - louder than shouting, yelling
fp - <u>fortepiano</u> - <u>loud/strong</u> then immediately quiet/soft
sf - subito forte - suddenly strong, staying within the general dynamic indicated previously
rf - rinforzando - reinforced, but not as much as the accent, a leaning on but not harshly
fz - <u>forzando</u> - <u>the sharp accenting of a note or group of notes</u>
sfz - sforzando - sudden strong accent, with great force of a percussive nature
cresc crescendo - growing, increasing, swelling, gradually becoming louder
dim diminuendo/ decrescendo - diminishing, decreasing, shrinking, gradually becoming softer
al niente - (fade) to nothing
calando - becoming less, becoming slower and softer, fading away
calmando - becoming calmer
leno - faint, gentle, quiet
morendo - slowly dying away, slow ritardando and a diminuendo with an extreme fade
perdendo/perdendosi - losing (itself/oneself) - gradually diminishing in volume, tempo, and tone
sotto voce - in a low voice (whisper)
sordino - use a mute (whispered)
smorzando - growing fainter, smoldering, becoming muffled, dulling
subito - suddenly, immediately, at once
