AUDIENCE CONCERT ETIQUETTE

- 1. Be on <u>*TIME*</u>. Late comers will be asked to <u>*WAIT*</u> until the appropriate time to enter.
- 2. Refrain from <u>*TALKING*</u>.
- 3. Remain <u>SILENT</u> and stay seated while the <u>PERFORMANCE</u> is in progress.
- 4. Turn off all <u>CELL PHONES</u> and <u>WATCH ALARMS</u>.
- 5. Do not take *FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY*.
- 6. No <u>SINGING</u>, tapping <u>FINGERS</u> or <u>FEET</u>.
- 7. <u>GUM</u>, <u>CANDY</u>, <u>FOOD</u> and <u>DRINK</u> are not allowed.
- 8. No <u>WATCHES</u> with alarms or jangle jewelry.
- 9. Do not <u>SIGH</u> with boredom.
- 10. Do not <u>APPLAUD</u> between movements.
- 11. Do not embarrass your PARENTS, TEACHER, SCHOOL, or CLASSMATES.
- 12. Do not <u>**READ**</u> nor <u>**PLAY**</u> with a toy in your pocket during the concert.
- 13. <u>STAY</u> for the whole concert.
- 14. Do not *LEAVE* the auditorium while another orchestra is playing.
- 15. If you must leave, *LEAVE* in between songs.
- 16. Turn your <u>PHONE</u> completely off.

PERFORMER'S STAGE PRESENCE

- 1. <u>WALK</u> quietly with your <u>INSTRUMENT</u> onto the stage in an orderly fashion.
- 2. Take out music in concert order and adjust your <u>STAND</u> high enough to see the conductor.
- 3. Make sure stands are <u>CLOSE</u> but not crowding the conductor's <u>PODIUM</u>.
- 4. First chair cello will watch for the <u>CONDUCTOR</u> back stage.
- 5. When the conductor walks onto the stage, everyone <u>STANDS</u>.
- 6. The conductor will <u>BOW</u>; the orchestra will be motioned to be <u>SEATED</u>.
- 7. The <u>ORCHESTRA</u> plays their repertoire. The <u>AUDIENCE</u> applauses.
- 8. When all concert pieces are played, the conductor will motion for the **ORCHESTRA** to stand.
- 9. The orchestra \underline{EXITS} the stages, and the next orchestra \underline{SETS} \underline{UP} to play.
- 10. As you return to your seats, turn your <u>MUSIC</u> in to the concert master immediately after you play.
